There is an office visit/exam fee of \$25 for comprehensive exams or for adult pets that are not spayed/neutered unless a pre-paid spay/neuter apt. is made!* Please Note! To keep our fees low there will be a \$1 fee for credit card payments due to large bank fee increases. Due to the large number of returned checks, we can not accept personal checks, sorry! Cash is preferred.

**\*Vaccines require a very brief doctor's exam to see if the pet is healthy enough to receive vaccines. For vaccines only, the exam is \$10. Note! Unaltered adult pet exams are always \$25 unless a pre-paid spay/neuter appointment is made!**

### Spay/Neuter and Other Surgery

- Cat Spay or Neuter—\$50
- Dog Spay or Neuter—\$75 (over 75 lbs. \$95)
- Supplemental Pain Medication for Post Surgery—\$12
- Pregnant or in-heat dogs will be an additional \$15
- Umbilical Hernia Repair—\$15
- Crypt is an additional \$25.
- “Cherry Eye” Removal - \$75 with Spay/Neuter, \$100 without Spay/Neuter
- Entropion - \$100 with Spay/Neuter, \$125 without Spay/Neuter
- Tumor Removal - \$50+ (depending on location and severity)
- Rear Dew Claw Removal - \$75 per set (with Spay/Neuter, \$100 without)

**Vaccinations**

Most common infectious diseases can be **prevented by routine vaccination.** Pets, like people, can be protected from many highly contagious and deadly diseases by vaccination. The widespread use of vaccines within the last century has helped prevent death and disease in millions of animals. Since vaccines are generally very safe and relatively inexpensive, there's just no reason to let your pet go unprotected. Vaccinating your pet is often cheaper than paying for treating your sick pet later, and reduces virus transmission in the pet population. **NAWS recommends a 3 year rabies vaccine for pets that have had at least one rabies vaccine in the past. We recommend a staggered 3 year rotation on rabies, distemper and other vaccines based on the pet's needs.**

*Please note:* If a pet has never received a vaccine before, and is over 16 weeks old, it will need one additional dose in 3 to 4 weeks before starting on the annual or triennial schedule.

**Record of Vaccination:** You will go home with a copy of your pet's medical record each time you visit our clinic. Always bring all medical records regarding your pet with you when you visit our clinic. If you do not have any prior medical records or vaccination records, it is OK.
